Today's Scripture Passage: Psalm 125 | Page 441 Pew Bible

1 Those who trust in the LORD are like Mount Zion, which cannot be shaken but endures forever. 2 As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the LORD surrounds his people both now and forevermore. 3 The scepter of the wicked will not remain over the land allotted to the righteous, for then the righteous might use their hands to do evil. 4 Do good, O LORD, to those who are good, to those who are upright in heart. 5 But those who turn to crooked ways the LORD will banish with the evildoers. Peace be upon Israel.

Questions for Reflection & Discussion

- 1. Psalm 125 gives a picture of the mountains encircling Jerusalem. The Psalmist likens it to God's protection over us. Describe a time when you experienced God's protection.
- 2. Is trust (vs. 1) necessary for security?
- 3. What do you think it means that "those who trust in the Lord are like Mt. Zion?" (vs. 1) How does trust affect us?
- 4. How are trust and security related?

Prayer Points

- 1. Ask God to increase our trust in Him, and remove our insecurities.
- 2. Ask God to guide our church through this transitional time, in such a way that we grow in our capacity to trust Him.
