 - Motivate Like A Dad. (vs. 11) prompt without provocation – security vs. success not his dreams(vision) but our potential.
 - Have A Goal (vs. 12)

- Allowing ministry to define identity
- Allowing biblical knowledge to define spiritual maturity
- Confusing blessing with endorsement
- Isolation
- Self Delusion
- Losing Sense of Awe

- A. Encourage Pastor to attend small group he doesn't lead.
- B. Encourage Pastor to have a Mentor.

- F. Be gracious to the Pastor (give benefit of doubt)
- G. Only expect Pastor to "coach" and participate in ministry not be the "boss" of it.
