and a haughty spirit before a fall.  
19 It is better to be of a lowly spirit with the poor  
than to divide the spoil with the proud.

20 Whoever gives thought to the word will discover good, and blessed is  
he who trusts in the Lord.

26 A worker's appetite works for him;  
his mouth urges him on.

33 The lot is cast into the lap,  
but its every decision is from the Lord.

- How does it feel to know that Jesus' highway is better and that he wants to use it to preserve your life? V.17
- How has God shown you that following him in humility is better than having too high an opinion of yourself? V.18-19
- Does God want you to pursue others who know better than you do about an area of life? Have you been neglecting what God has to say in a particular area of your life? How can you show more trust in God in that area? V.20
- Has your appetite proven to be a motivator for your work? How so? V.26
- Are you submitting your decisions to the Lord? Are you growing impatient waiting for answers? V.33
